A large and sophisticated network to provide services to **35 million people**, who identify themselves as Mexican or Mexican-American.

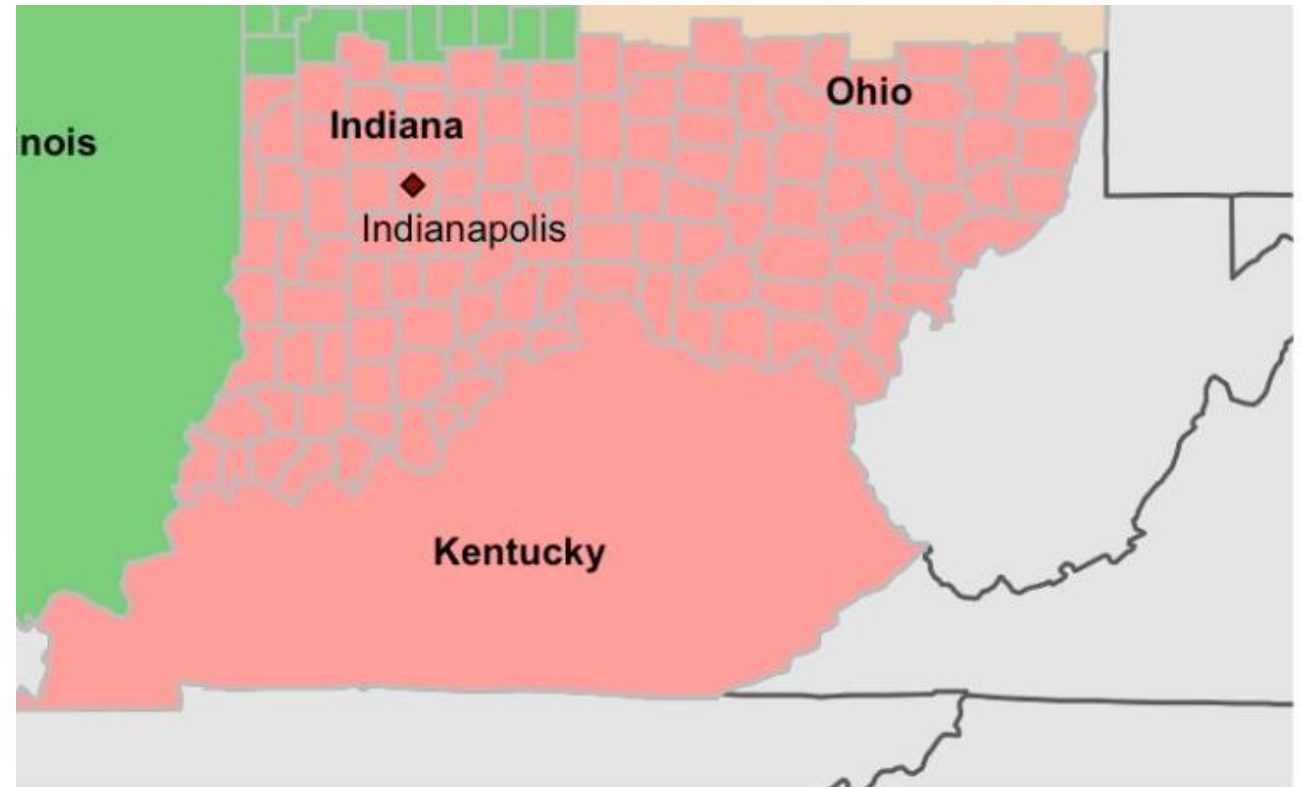

NEW MEXICAN ELECTRONIC PASSPORT



- The new electronic passports have **more than 50 security features**, such as a chip with biographical and biometric information, to prevent tampering or forgeries.
- **Non-binary passports**, in which you can mark with an **X** in the gender box.

Birth certificates that recognize the gender identity of individuals



Conoce los requisitos para la expedición de una nueva acta de nacimiento por reconocimiento de identidad de género en el exterior:

- I. Copia certificada de tu acta de nacimiento;
- II. Identificación con fotografía;
- III. Dos testigos;
- IV. Las personas menores de edad, deberán acompañarse de quien o quienes ejerzan la patria potestad.

Ese mismo día se podrá expedir el pasaporte y matrícula consular.

Acude a tu consulado más cercano. La primera expedición de tu acta es gratuita y el trámite es confidencial.

- To process them, you do not need to present any kind of proof of marital status, medical or psychological certifications, or diagnosis or procedure: *it is enough to express your will to carry out the procedure and state verbally or in writing your gender identity.*

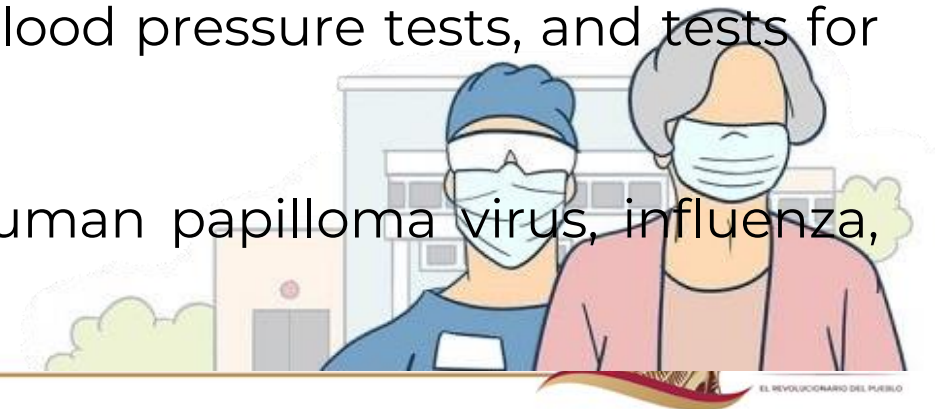
Community Affairs (VDS) Health Initiative

Promotes a culture of preventive health care among Mexicans and their families living in the US by providing **information, education, counseling and quality referrals** in a safe and friendly environment through local health agencies

The Mexican Consulate in Indianapolis has served as a **COVID-19 vaccination site** as part of ongoing efforts to reach vulnerable communities.

Weekly health fairs are held to offer glucose tests, blood pressure tests, and tests for sexually transmitted diseases, among others.

In addition, we provide **vaccines** against tetanus, human papilloma virus, influenza, and hepatitis.

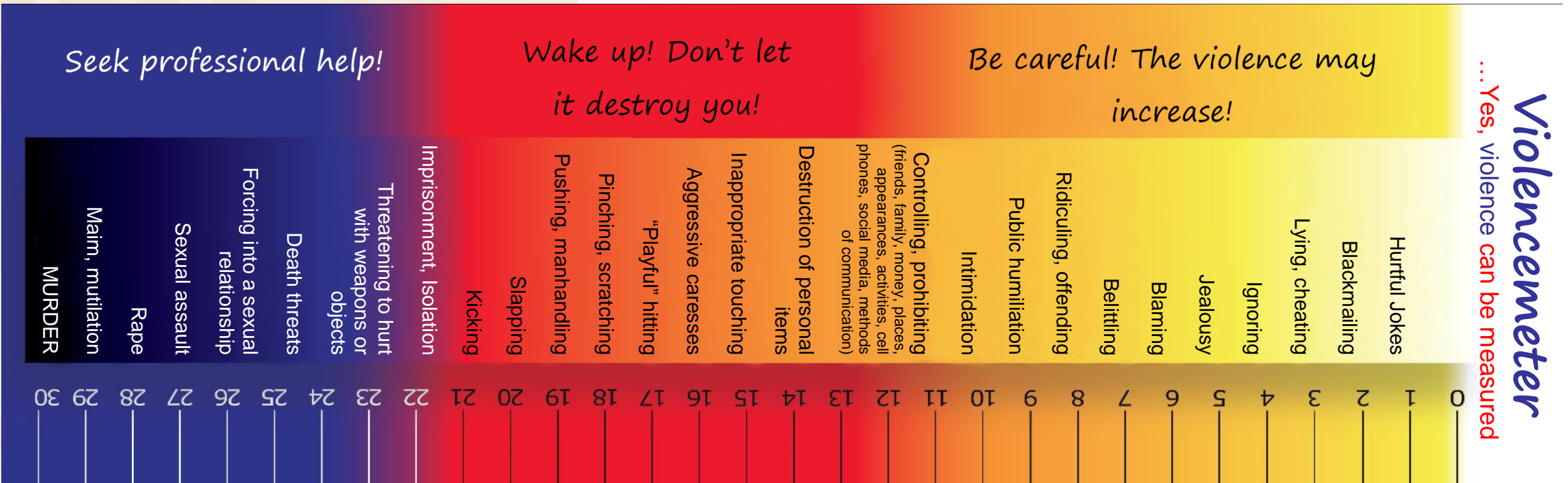

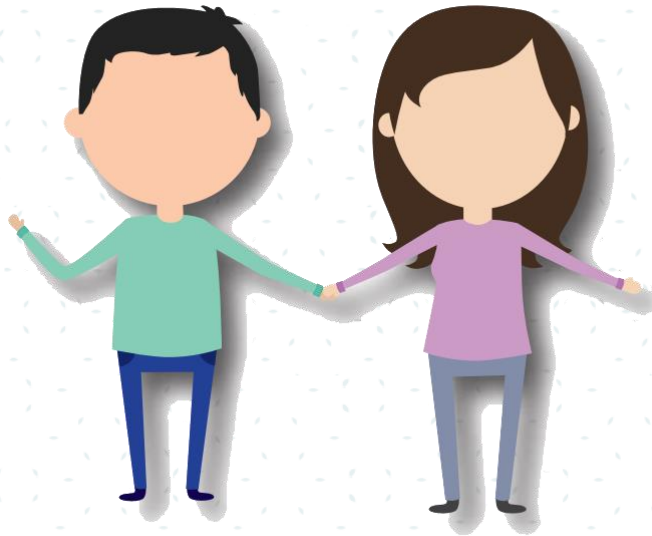

A hate crime is:

- A criminal act against a person or property.
- When the victim is intentionally chosen because of the victim's actual or perceived:



Race, Ethnicity, National Origin



Sexual Orientation



Religion



Disability



Gender, Gender Identity



What to do if you are a victim or if you witness a hate crime?

1. Report it to law enforcement.
2. Recount exactly what was said or done during the incident.
3. If you are reluctant to contact the police for any reason, you can report it to the Mexican Consulate.

If you are a victim or if you witness a hate crime, **report it!**
